Language Policy

1. The language of instruction and assessment at the school is English Home Language.
2. Afrikaans First Additional Language is offered in Grade 1 – 7 and forms part of the progress requirements.
3. isiZulu is offered in Grade 1 – 3 as the Second Additional Language, but is not part of the progress requirements

School Fees Policy

1. We are a fee paying school. We do not offer any bursaries / scholarships.

Process and Information

1. Follow the online process on www.gdeadmissions.gov.za then come to school.
2. You can upload your supporting documents on the online system or submit certified copies of the documents to ALL schools applied to within 7 days of end of the application period
3. You will receive an acknowledgment/receipt for your manual document submission.
4. You will be informed as to whether your child's application has been successful or not once the GDE has approved the application.
5. Once your child is accepted at this school, the parent is required to complete the school application form which is specific to the school in order to have all information as per our database requirements and submit certified hardcopies of all supporting documents (if you have not done so before). This does not replace the online admissions process and is only applicable once your child is accepted at this school.
6. Once the application is approved and you accept placement, you are requested to pay a deposit of R1000.00 (Grade R – 7); (which will be deducted from the 2022 school fee.
7. This deposit is refundable should the child not come to school in January 2022.
8. The stationery pack fee will be due by 30/11/2021 once prices are confirmed.
9. If you are unsuccessful, you will be given reasons in writing by the school and the address of the MEC so that you may lodge an appeal if you wish to.

Document submission:

1. Applicants must provide documents as per the documents checklist and you must adhere to the timeframes to ensure that your application is not rejected due to non or late submission of documents.
2. Parents must submit certified copies of the documents to ALL schools applied to within 7 days of end of the application period.

Important dates

- Applications period: 13/09/2021 – 08/10/2021
- Document submission: Parents must submit the supporting documents to all schools they applied to within 7 days after application. 13/09/2021 – 15/10/2021
- Notification of the outcome of your application: 12/11/2021 – 30/11/2021. Parents receive automated messages (SMS); generated by the System and informing them of successful and unsuccessful applications
- Parents accept/reject placement offers within 7 school days. 15/11/2021 – 30/11/2021.
- Parents must confirm offers of placement within 7 days of receipt of offers of placement during the Placement Period

Waiting lists/Feeder Zones:

- Placement of applicants will be based on the following admissions criteria, ranked in the order outlined below:
- 1st - Home Address closest to school within Feeder zone
- 2nd - Sibling at the school
- 3rd - Work address within Feeder zone
- 4th - Home Address within 30kms
- 5th - Home address is Beyond 30kms of the school
- Placement will be prioritised at the school closest to the parent's HOME address
